Collaborative Learning

- ◆ **Coursework in Collaborative Learning**
Development of Student-Centered Active Learning.
- ◆ **"Task-based" Research Activities**
Cooperatively study Maritime Challenges and Opportunities with relation to Disasters, Business, People, Culture, and the Natural Area of Sanriku.
- ◆ **"Innovative and Creative Approaches"**
Domestic and International Collaborative Research Activities to Develop Comprehensive Scientific Thinking Skills.

East Japan Earthquake Reconstruction

- ◆ **Stimulation & Development of Motivation**
Consider the role of groups and society for helping stimulate motivation for positive action in daily life.
- ◆ **Disaster Preparedness Studies**
Take the lessons learned from the earthquake disaster, and share and exchange information with those who have had similar experiences.
